



The Committee has received a number of complaints this season regarding SLOW PLAY, and are therefore keen to try and address this by bringing it to the attention of all members and visitors playing Alyth Golf Course.

We are very keen to try and encourage members and visitors to become more aware of the importance of maintaining an acceptable speed of play with a view that, if players fall behind the group in front, they should stand aside and allow the following group through.

A ruling from the Committee is therefore being introduced with immediate effect, that if a group has fallen a hole behind, they **MUST** on request from players behind allow that following group to play through if they are being held up. In this way any gaps created in the field are liable to be shortened and general speed of play improved.

We trust that all members will take this request seriously and see it as an effort to improve the golfing experience at Alyth for ALL.
